Course In „Palliative Care” for students of faculty of medicine

1. Palliative Care is an obligatory subject for students of VI year of Faculty of Medicine and is carried out in forms: seminars and workshops
2. Seminars and workshops usually take place in seminar room No 210 (Żołnierska Street 48)
3. The workshops are carried out in 10-12 group of students per tutor
4. Participation in seminars and workshops is obligatory
5. One day of classes takes place in the Hospice under invocation of St. Christopher in Gorzów Wlkp.
6. All classes and seminars start punctually both for tutors and students. People, who come late, or who come to classes with their coats on, may not be admitted in.
7. Necessary conditions, which must be met to obtain credit of the subject, are: presence at all seminars and workshops, and mastering knowledge proved by written test taken at completion of classes.
8. In case of excused absence from one seminar, a credit can be obtained against oral test on subject taken at the tutor; however the time limit is 2 weeks from a correct date of a class missed at the latest
9. Students, who fail to obtain credit from written test, should obtain credit from the subject in oral form taken at the tutor, however the time limit is 2 weeks from the date of the latest seminar
10. Entry in a student’s record book and credit chard can be received against fulfilment of above conditions. The following should be entered in the respective columns:
