

**The Syllabus of learning Polish for
Students of the English Programme
Faculty of Dentistry**

Department of Foreign Languages

The syllabus is a follow-up to the intensive course of Polish for students of the English Programme held in September.

It is designed for students of the first and second year of medical studies and includes 120 hours.

I semester	- 30 h
II semester	- 30 h
III semester	- 60 h

Main objectives:

1. Learning Polish for specific purposes:
 - a.) reading and understanding simple Polish texts
 - b.) speaking (e.g. interviewing a patient, instructions to a patient)
 - c.) understanding the spoken language (answering questions, giving quick responses)
2. Acquiring basic grammatical structures within a medical context.

The programme of the three – semester course includes:

1. Reinforcement of the language skills gained in the September course.
2. Describing school timetable and discussing medical studies in Poland.
3. Dialogues in a restaurant, shops, post office, railway station etc.
4. Entertainment; ways of spending free time.
5. Introduction of the basic anatomical terminology.
 - describing parts of the human body
 - basic organs and their location
 - respiratory, circulatory, digestive system
6. Description of the most common diseases, their symptoms and signs.
7. Naming basic medical specializations, wards, specialists and their duties.
8. Oral hygiene
9. Dental team; duties and procedures
10. Dental specializations
11. Interviewing a dental patient, taking case history.

Use of Polish (Grammar).

- A) Alphabet, pronunciation.
- B) Making general and detailed questions.
- C) Expressing past, present and future activities.
- D) Giving orders, advice, permission.
- E) Comparative and superlative forms of adjectives.
- F) Expressing positive and negative feelings and opinions.
