For what period will we process your data?	<p>Your personal data will be processed for the period required to carry out the recruitment procedure for the programme and the until the time limitation for claims and the end of the evaluation and monitoring of the project.</p> <p>After the last of those period passes, your personal data will be removed and made anonymous.</p>
What rights do you have in regards to the processing of your personal data?	<p>Because your personal data is processed by us, you can exercise the rights to access your data, correct it, remove it, restrict its processing and transfer. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with a body supervising compliance with personal data protection regulations.</p> <p>Notwithstanding the aforementioned rights, you can object to have your data processed within the scope of the legitimate interests of the data controller or the public interest. Your personal data will no longer be processed for those purposes, unless it is stated, that there are legal grounds which override your interests, rights and freedoms or unless your data will be necessary in order to determine, investigate or defend claims.</p> <p>To make sure that you are entitled to use the aforementioned rights, we may ask you to provide additional information that would help us with the identification.</p>
Do you have to provide your personal data?	<p>Providing your personal data is voluntary, however if you do not provide them, you may not be able to take part in the recruitment process.</p>
What else should you know?	<p>We will not pass your personal information outside EOG. We will not process your data by an automated means.</p>
