§1

Sposób prowadzenia zajęć

Teaching Methods

1. The Microbiology & Immunology course comprises of:
 - seminars (20 hours),
 - practical classes (20 hours).
2. The course is arranged in the winter semester of the 2nd year and ends with **final theoretical examination** in the winter semester of 2nd year.
3. The detailed programme of the course, which contains the topics of particular classes as well as relevant literature, is displayed on the website:

4. According to the resolution no. 124/2014 of the Pomeranian Medical University Senate, all lectures (seminars) as well as all practical classes attendance is found obligatory.

§2

Sposób i formy wyrównywania zaległości, w tym odrabiania zajęć na skutek nieobecności

Mode and forms of compensation of missed activities

1. Each absence must be documented and justified.
2. Relevant certificate (eg. sick leave, dean's leave, subpoena) verifying the absence must be provided to the course Assistant as soon as possible, during the first class following the absence, latest.
3. The absence on the seminar results in essay performance, related to the lecture topic.
4. The absence on the practical class requires passing the theory as well as practical part performance.
5. Practical retakes can be made under following circumstances:
 - with another English speaking group during the same week of practical class if such a group with relevant topic is arranged in the schedule.
 - after passing the theoretical issues corresponding to the practice at the end of semester during extra class organized to catch up on practical class
6. In case of absence rate over 50%, no retakes opportunities will be provided and this will result in class credit refusal and in the exclusion of the student from the final examination (red condition)
7. Punctuality is required during the course. Each student noted with threefold late has to prepare a presentation on the topic chosen by the Assistant and to present it during last class or during online meeting on MS Teams platform.
8. §2 section 1-6 are applicable to the E-learning, excluding §2 section 5 (in person at the Department)

Warunki i sposoby dopuszczania studentów do zaliczeń i egzaminów

Requirements for course completion in order to sit the credit of exam

1. **Requirements** to get the **class credit** of the course are following:
 - all the practical classes attendance
 - all the practical protocols approval
 - all the class tests passed (average mark at least 3.0).
2. **Requirements** to sit the **final exam** are following:
 - all the seminars attendance
 - class credit (all rules in §3 section 1)

§4

Zasady dopuszczające studenta do poszczególnych zajęć w danym roku akademickim*

*Principles of attending classes during the academic year**

1. The practical classes are organized within the groups established at the Dean's Office
2. **Any rearrangement from one to another students' group has to be established with course coordinator after the first week of class, latest.**
3. Each student is obliged to prepare him/herself for every class in terms of theoretical issues relevant to the class, as scheduled in the program.
4. A student will not be allowed to attend class if:
 - **being more than 20 minutes late,**
 - **lacks protective clothing – laboratory coat**
 - attends the class with another group without a prior consent of the coordinator of the course,
 - behaves inconsistently with the study regulations, disrupts the classes, threatens safety, lacks personal culture to the teacher and other classmates

§5

Forms of credits, exams

CLASS TEST

1. Class test relevant to the class topic is conducted out during practical class; e-learning assessment - via recommended online platform based on the e-learning schedule.
2. Class test consists of 10 questions (single- choice test questions, key-choice test questions, essay questions), relevant to the class topic, as scheduled in the program.
3. Each student is entitled to three terms of the class test,
1st term - during the practical class
2nd term- during the three following weeks, within the duty hours of the Assistant relevant for particular group (date arranged by the Assistant)
3rd term shared for all students at the end of winter semester in the classroom. This 3rd term of retake covers all the failed/missed class tests. Failure of 3rd term will result in class credit refusal and failure to pass the course (red condition).
4. **Class test (1st term) and class test retakes (2nd and 3rd term) have a written form.**
5. Absence/failure to join the class test/class test retakes via online platform (if e-learning) must be documented by relevant certificate (§2 section 2). Unjustified absence/failure becomes equivalent to loss of the term of class test/class test retakes.

PRACTICAL PROTOCOLS

1. Each student is obliged **to print** the relevant practical protocol(s) and fulfills practical tasks during the practical class(es). Fulfilled printed version of protocols are submitted to the teacher's approval. Protocol approval results in receiving the credit for the relevant practical part. Disapproved protocols need to be repeated during subsequent classes or additional classes at the end of semester. The online version of protocol requires the Assistant consent and teacher's approval; **it is not allowed to use the mobile/phone version of the protocols.**

FINAL EXAMINATION

1. **The final examination** consists of **50 single/key-choice test questions** related to the material included in the recommended literature, presented during the seminars and discussed during the practical classes.
2. The final examination takes place in Exam Centre (CET) and each student is obliged to respect CET rules.
3. Each student is entitled to information about number of points obtained immediately after examination platform closure or during the 7 working days following the test date.
4. Final test outcomes will be displayed on the website (*Virtual Deans Office*) during the 7 working days following the examination first term date.
5. In case of first final examination failure, each student is entitled to 2 retakes. The retakes rules are analogous to the first exam term - 1st and 2nd retake have the form of the test exam.
6. Unjustified absence on the final examination either on retakes will result in examination negative grade.
7. Absence justification certificate must be delivered to Department's secretary office (copy of certificate) and to Dean's Office of Medicine & Dentistry Faculty (original document) **within 7 days following the examination date**. Lacking justification or delayed justification (>7 days from examination date) will become equivalent to the unjustified absence.
8. According to the Rector's ordinance no. 71/2012, **this is strictly forbidden to use any electronic devices which enable either to communicate or to scan the contents of the test. Each student who is noted with using any of these, will be automatically disclosed from the test and will obtain a negative grade with no retake opportunities.**

Circumstances of exemption from credits or exams

- 1.No exemption from class test/s and the final examination will be provided.

§7

Warunki dopuszczenia studenta do egzaminu w tzw. przedterminie, o którym mowa w § 32 ust. 8 regulaminu Studiów

Form of admission to the pre-scheduled examination, referred to § 32 point 8 of Rules & Regulations of PMU

1. Each student who fulfills cumulative conditions:
 - achieves the average grade of all class test 4.5
 - passed all class tests in their first term,
 - has not been noted with unjustified absenceswill be entitled to take the final examination in a pre-term.
2. Pre-term examination has an oral form.
3. The detailed date of the pre-term examination will be arranged after completing of all the classes.
4. At the conditions stated at §7, the pre-term exam may be held only if current epidemic status allows.
5. Tightening the epidemic prevention restrictions will result in §7 section 1-3 exemption and student who meet the requirements stated at §7 section 1 obtains 3 extra points added for the points result obtained in a first-term of final examination.

§8

Kryteria oceniania

Assessment criteria

1. There is no possibility to improve the positive result of particular class tests.
2. Class tests assessment criteria - for each correct single choice answer, 1 point can be obtained, while 0,5 or 1 point can be obtained for each correct essay answer. The scoring is converted into grading system; at least 60% correctness is required to obtain a positive grade - 3,0.
3. Final examination assessment criteria: 60% correctness in answers is required to pass the final test.
Scoring criteria and the grading are following:
 - <30 pkt (less than 60%)- insufficient
 - 30-33 pkt (≥60%) – sufficient
 - 34-37 pkt (≥68%) – quite good
 - 38-41 pkt (≥76%)– good
 - 42-45 pkt (≥84%) – more than good
 - 46-50 pkt (≥92%) – very good
4. Each student who fulfills cumulative conditions:
 - achieves the grade-point average of all class test ≥ 4.0
 - passed all class tests in the first term,
 - has not been noted with unjustified absencesobtains **1 extra** point added for points result obtained in first-term of final examination
5. Each student who meet the requirements stated at §7 section 1 obtains 3 extra points added for the points result obtained in a first-term of final examination if pre-term exam cannot be conducted out because of anti-epidemic restrictions.
