§1

Sposób prowadzenia zajęć

Teaching Methods

1. Physiology activities are conducted in 3rd semester in form of seminars and practical classes (units). All activities are mandatory, knowledge of their content is necessary for crediting both semesters and passing final examination. Some seminars are performed in e-learning mode. Seminars and practical classes are scheduled in series of activities (cycles) covering following important physiological topics. Detailed plan of activities in Department of Physiology is published separately. Student's knowledge is tested at the end of each cycle and graded in scale applicable at the university.
2. Classes include preparation of students for practicals, understanding of the part of programme intended for particular activity, proper performance, interpretation and explanation of tasks introducing to activities in hospital departments (diagnostic tests, assessment of chosen parameters of the cardiovascular and respiratory system, laboratory tests, virtual simulations on model tissues/organs, etc.). Additional element of the class is a short test written by students at the beginning of particular meeting.

§2

Mode and forms of compensation of missed activities

1. In the event of absence from any physiology activity, the student is obliged to make it up in term and form suggested by the teacher responsible for the English Course (tutor) or during the last activity of the particular cycle. In opposite case student is not allowed to begin the cycle test, failing the cycle test in first term.
2. It is allowed to make up absent activity with another group of students doing the same topic, after prior consent of the particular student's teacher or tutor. In all remaining cases the date and the form of such the repetitive activity is decided by tutor. In opposite case student is not allowed to begin the cycle test, failing the cycle test in first term.
3. The only acceptable reasons for absence are Dean's and/or Doctor's notes (sick leaves); they have to be shown to the assistant immediately after the end of the absence time and noted in student's evidence.
4. During the semester student is allowed to be absent with no significant reason twice, once from the practice hours and once from the seminar but absences have to be made up in a way mentioned above.
5. Absence (regardless of the reason) from more than four practice classes and four seminars makes the credit of the semester impossible.

§3

Warunki i sposoby dopuszczania studentów do zaliczeń i egzaminów *Requirements for course completion in order to sit the credit of exam*

1. Criteria of the credit of practice hours (units) are: knowledge and understanding of the part of programme intended for particular class activity, proper performance, interpretation and explanation of particular tasks introducing to activities in medical departments (diagnostic tests, assessment of chosen parameters of the cardiovascular and respiratory system, laboratory tests, virtual simulations on model tissues/organs, etc.). Students' knowledge is tested every unit in form of short entry test. In case of failure of the unit student has to make it up during the last activity of the particular cycle. Lack of such condition equals to the failure of the first term of the cycle test.
2. Criterion of the credit of seminars is student's attendance. In case of the absence from seminar, student is obliged to make it up in term and form suggested by the teacher responsible for the English Course (tutor).
3. In case of the failure of any cycle test in first and second term, students have the right to take a re-take (third term of the cycle test) during the essay test performed not later than one week before the end of the didactic period of the academic year.
4. Negative grade of the third term of any cycle test results with the failure of all the physiology course. Student who finally failed the course is allowed to apply for conditional credit. Student is allowed to take another test covering previously failed cycle tests, losing the first term of the final exam. Such a test is planned before the term of the first re-sit exam (receiving negative grade in first term of the exam).
5. To credit the physiology course in student has to:

- Make up all absent activities (seminars, units).
- Pass all cycle tests.
- Have not more than one unjustified absences from practice hours (unit), not more than one unjustified absence from seminar regardless the reason.
- Have not more than four absences from classes, not more than four from seminars).

§4

Zasady dopuszczające studenta do poszczególnych zajęć w danym roku akademickim*

*Principles of attending classes during the academic year**

1. During all activities student should wear a laboratory coat.
2. Student will not be allowed to enter Department being late more than 20 minutes and not possessing laboratory coat.
3. Student will not be allowed attend activities in result of inappropriate behaviour, inconsistent with the regulations of studies.
4. Being asked to leave the class means to fail the activity.

§5

Warunki i sposoby przeprowadzania zaliczeń przedmiotu i egzaminów

Forms of credits, exams

1. Student's knowledge is tested at the end of each cycle and graded in scale applicable at the university. Students have the right to re-take the failed cycle test. Both (the second and the third) terms of the cycle test are organized at the same time for all students. The first and the second term of the cycle test is a multiple-choice test with key answer. In third term cycle test may be an essay test, multiple choice test with key answer or oral test. Test questions originate from mandatory textbooks, seminars and classes of the physiology course.
2. In case of justified absence on first and/or second term of the cycle test the test (essay test) and date of the retake is decided by the tutor. Such a test has to be performed not later than 2 weeks after the end of the absence time. Not justified absence from cycle test results with the failure of particular term of the test.
3. Physiology examination can be taken only by students who passed both cycle tests. In first term it is a multiple-choice test with key answer.
4. The type of the test in following terms of physiology examination depends on the number of students who failed previous term (terms) and tutor's decision.

§6

Warunki zwalniania z niektórych zaliczeń lub egzaminów

Circumstances of exemption from credits or exams

1. Final average grade of all cycle tests passed in first terms equal to at least 4.5, lack of unjustified absences, not more than 3 absences from any activities and passing of cycle tests in first attempt is the basis for exemption from the exam with the grade 5.0.

**Kryteria oceniania
Assessment criteria**

1. Grades of cycle tests and final examination will be issued in accordance with §37 of Rules of Studies in Pomeranian Medical University of Szczecin.
2. The final score in first term of the exam is increased by the preferential points calculated dependently on final average grade calculated from all cycle tests. It is increased by 1 point per every 0.1 of the average beginning with 4.0 (i.e.: average 4,0 gives +1 point, 4.1 gives +2 points, 4.2 gives +3 points, 4.3 gives +4 points, 4.4 gives +5 points).
