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## Guidelines for the preparation of the case presentation in Department of Integrated Dentistry.

- 1. The presentation should comprise 10-15 slides (up to 10 minutes).
- 2. Description of the initial examination should be accompanied by the following photographies: frontal facial with lip in rest and smile, profile, intraoral in occlusion (frontal occlusion and posterior occlusion), intraoral occlusal of the upper and lower dental arches. Then, clinical diagnosis, oral hygiene assessment with staining dental plaque, periodontal examination (PSR), supplementary diagnostic records (radiologic or others), patients expectations and plan of prophylaxis and treatment.
- 3. A mandatory part of the presentation is photographic documentation of the relevant area or tooth taken before, during and after the procedure, as well as X-rays and possible photos of models. Description of the procedures performed (i.e. plaque staining, scaling, conservative treatment and other therapeutic interventions).
- 4. Photographs and their descriptions should be placed on the same slides. Front size should be no smaller than 20 points (figure description). No more than 10 text lines should be placed on a slide. Thus all persons watching the presentations are obligated to keep medical confidence, there is no need to cover patient's eyes.
- 5. All the presentations should be copied into the Department's computer to folder named by student's group and academic year.
- 6. The authors of the most interesting case presentations may receive assistant's support if preparing a publication.
