

Ordinance No. 11/2022

of the Rector of Pomeranian Medical University in Szczecin from ...
February 2022 changing the Regulation No. 91/2021 on introducing
"Rules of Erasmus+ Programme in Pomeranian Medical University in
Szczecin for students, doctoral students and graduates".

Pursuant to Article 23 of the Act of July 20 2018 on higher education and science
(Journal of Laws of 2021, item 478, as amended) in connection with § 49 section 1 of the
Statute of the Pomeranian Medical University in Szczecin, I order as follows:

§ 1

Point 2 of the Annex to the Ordinance No. 91/2021 of the Rector of the Pomeranian Medical
University in Szczecin of 27 July 2021 on the introduction of "Principles of operation of the
Erasmus+ Programme at the Pomeranian Medical University in Szczecin for students,
doctoral students and graduates", is amended as follows:

- 1) Subsection (6) is replaced by the following:

*"The funding period for study travel is a maximum of 5 months for one-semester stays
and a maximum of 9 months for two-semester stays. Beyond this period, only
additional days for green travel may be financed. The subsidy will be granted to the
participant only for the time of their actual stay in the country of the host university /
institution, which will be confirmed in the document constituting the transcript of
credits, in a certificate of stay, or in a separate document issued by the host university
/ institution.";*

- 2) Subsection 20 is replaced by the following:

*"When using sustainable means of transport such as green travel (train, bus, shared
car, boat), students/doctoral fellows and graduates are entitled to a one-off individual
support of €50 when meeting green travel requirements."*

- 3) After subsection 20, the following subsections 21-23 are added:

"21) If the trip is at least 12 hours one-way, the participant is entitled to additional
support per day of green travel, but not for more than 4 days of travel.

22) A statement from the participant receiving green travel support, indicating the
mode of transportation and the number of days of green travel, is evidence of
compliance with green travel requirements.

23) A participant benefiting from green travel support is obliged to keep evidence of
such travel (in particular tickets) and to present it for inspection upon request by the
University." .

§ 2

The Ordinance shall take effect on the date of signature.
