### §1

#### Sposób prowadzenia zajęć

##### *Teaching Methods*

1. Practical classes in one of the Internal Medicine departments, assigned for each student.
2. Classes in the Medical Simulation Center (CSM)

### §2

#### Sposób i formy wyrównywania zaległości, w tym odrabiania zajęć na skutek nieobecności

##### *Mode and forms of compensation of missed activities*

1. Any absence must be compensated. Each department decides how to make up for the missed class.

### §3

#### Warunki i sposoby dopuszczania studentów do zaliczeń i egzaminów

##### *Requirements for course completion in order to sit the credit of exam*

1. A student gets the credit after finishing all practical classes and gaining skills and qualifications specified in the 6th year program. It shall be confirmed with a signature (in the „Practical training record book”) of an assistant/coordinator of the Department in which the student finishes the practical classes.

### §4

#### Warunki i sposoby przeprowadzania zaliczeń przedmiotu i egzaminów

##### *Forms of credits, exams*

1. The exam in Internal Medicine consists of two parts: theoretical and practical.
2. Theoretical part in the first term is a test exam for the whole year with the rules as follows:
  - 100 questions covering the whole program of Internal Medicine including: propedeutics of internal medicine (3rd year), endocrinology, cardiology, gastrology, rheumatology, hematology, diabetology, nephrology, pulmonary diseases.
  - single choice questions

- duration 150 minutes
- 60 points (60%) to pass
- grades in the exam:
  - ◆ very good - 5.0 ( $\geq 92$  pts),
  - ◆ better than good - 4.5 (84-91 pts),
  - ◆ good - 4.0 (76-83 pts),
  - ◆ satisfactory - 3.5 (68-75 pts),
  - ◆ sufficient - 3.0 (60-67),
  - ◆ fail - 2.0 (less than 60 pts).
  
- any complaints and objections regarding the form and contents of the examination questions shall be written down at the back of the answer card and submitted to the exam supervising staff, right after finishing the exam
- in case of failing the first term the students have the right to re-take the theoretical exam twice
- The form of the second term retake will depend on how many students will fail in the first term: if more than 20% fail in the first term – it will be a test again with the rules as above if less than 20% fail in the first term – it will be an oral exam in the Department where the student takes the practical exam
- The third term is an oral exam in the Department where the student takes the practical exam

### 3. Practical exam

- is performed by the randomly assigned examiners in each of the Internal Medicine Departments
- checks the student's skills in history taking, physical examination, assessing laboratory and imaging tests (ECG, X-Ray) and clinical discussion with medical reasoning, differential diagnosis and proposing the treatment.
- In case of failing the first term the students have the right to re-take the practical exam twice with the same examiner. First retake shall be no sooner than after two weeks and third term between 1st August and 15th September

### 4. The final grade

- is an average of the grades from theoretical and practical part rounded up with accuracy of 0,5
- passing both theoretical and practical part is necessary to pass the whole exam

5. Exam preparation resources:

- Davidson's Principles and Practice of Medicine 23rd Edition
- Seminars in each of the Internal Medicine departments throughout the studies (from third to sixth year)
