§1**Sposób prowadzenia zajęć***Teaching Methods*

1. Pathomorphology and oral pathology course comprises 1 semester of lectures, seminars and practical classes.
2. Lectures, seminars and practical classes are obligatory and presence is registered.
3. During the course student must pass 2 multiple-choice tests according to the schedule. Test questions are based on:
 - a. Kumar, Abbas, Aster at al "Robbins & Kumar Basic Pathology, **11th ed.** Elsevier Co., 2022 (ISBN: 9780323790185)
 - b. W. Domagała, M. Chosia, E. Uraśńska: "Atlas of histopathology". 1st edition, 2006 (ISBN 83-200-3476-0) and subjects taught during practical classes, seminars and lectures
 - c. J. Regezi, J. Sciubba, R. Jordan: Oral Pathology: Clinical Pathologic Correlations, Saunders; 7 edition 2016, ISBN-10: 0323297684, ISBN-13: 978-0323297684

§2**Sposób i formy wyrównywania zaległości, w tym odrabiania zajęć na skutek nieobecności***Mode and forms of compensation of missed activities*

1. Every absence must be justified and notified within one week from the last day of a non-attendance period.

2. In case of a **justified absence** student must learn the material discussed during the missed lecture, seminar and/or practical classes and student's comprehension of the material has to be checked within one week. It is a student's responsibility to make an appointment with a teacher.
3. In case of such an **unjustified absence** student must make an appointment with a teacher to demonstrate comprehension of the subject of the missing lecture, seminar and/or practical classes plus he/she must assist the pathologist in the surgical pathology gross room for 6 hours within one week of the time of justification to the nearest cycle test.
4. A student is expected to have no more than 2 absences per semester (including only one unjustified absence).
5. Students with more absences may not receive credit. Students who exceeds the allowed number of absences, e.g. due to prolonged illness of the student, will be considered on a case-by-case basis, and the decision will be made by the Head of the Department on her own or in consultation with the Dean.
6. Being late will be treated as justified absence hence it carries the same consequences as described for justified absence.
7. The student will not be allowed to attend classes if he/she is late for the classes for more than 20 minutes. It carries the same consequences as unjustified absence.
8. The student will not be admitted to the classes or will be withdrawn from them in case of inappropriate behavior disobedient to the study regulations or other regulations in force at the University, i.e. inappropriate behavior disrupting the conduct of classes, threatening health, life or property, as well as in case of being disrespectful in relation to the teacher or other students participating in the classes. Not admitting the student to the classes or asking the student to leave the classes in the cases mentioned above is equivalent to unjustified absence from the classes.

§3

Warunki i sposoby dopuszczania studentów do zaliczeń i egzaminów

Requirements for course completion to sit the credit of exam

1. To be eligible for a cycle test student must obtain credits from all lectures, seminars and practical classes preceding it not later than one week before the date of the test.
2. A failed test can be resubmitted twice. Retakes are in the formula of written answers for 5 questions. First retake will be within 14 days of the failed test, second retake in **January 2026**.
3. Unjustified absence during any test is regarded as a failed test.
4. An official note giving the reasons of an absence during any test should be delivered during one week after the date of a test by email: sekrpato@pum.edu.pl Failure to do so will be treated as an unjustified absence.
5. In case of justified absence from the cycle test, the student is still eligible to the first attempt, but the cycle test will take the form of a written answer to 5 questions.

§4

Zasady dopuszczające studenta do poszczególnych zajęć w danym roku akademickim*

*Principles of attending classes during the academic year**

1. Student is expected to read the appropriate passages from textbooks. Student's comprehension of material will be checked every week. In case of insufficient knowledge to obtain credit, a student must make an appointment with a teacher within one week to demonstrate comprehension of the subject in question.
2. Student's preparation for classes and seminars may be verified orally (oral answers to questions from the scope of classes or seminars) or in writing (written answers to 1 or 2 questions from the scope of classes or seminars). The results of written answers are announced to the students on the next working day at the latest.

§5

Warunki i sposoby przeprowadzania zaliczeń przedmiotu i egzaminów

Forms of credits, exams

1. Students are NOT ALLOWED to use mobile phones or any electronic equipment for any communication during the tests and final examination.

2. To complete the semester a student is expected to collect all the credits for lectures, seminars and classes till the **15.02.2026**.
3. To be eligible for the final examination a student is expected to pass all the 2 tests and collect all the credits.
4. Unjustified absence during the exam is regarded as a failed test.
5. An official note giving the reasons of an absence during the theory test should be delivered during one week after the date of a test by email sekrpato@pum.edu.pl. Failure to do so will be treated as an unjustified absence.

§6

Kryteria oceniania

Assessment criteria

1. Multiple choice cycle test consists of 44 questions. These are single-choice questions and multiple-choice questions with one correct answer. Students have one minute to answer each question.
2. For each correct answer the student collects 1 point. To pass the test student should collect minimum 26 points (60% correctly answered questions).
Grading scale for the cycle test:
26-29 pts = grade 3.0
30-32 pts = grade 3.5
33-36 pts = grade 4.0
37-39 pts = grade 4.5
40-44 pts = grade 5.0
3. A failed test can be resubmitted twice. Retakes are in the formula of written answers (essay) for 5 questions. For each correct and detailed answer the student collects 1 point. To pass the retake test student should collect minimum 3 points. For the retake student may get grade 3,0 (pass) or 2,0 (fail).
4. The final exam consists of the practical part (25 questions based on histological slides described during course)) and the theory multiple-choice test (100 questions). The final grade of the final exam is calculated from the sum of points from the practical and theoretical exam. To pass the exam student should collect 75 points (60% correctly answered questions).
A student, who obtains:
 - 75-84 points receives grade 3.0
 - 85-94 points receives grade 3.5
 - 95-104 points receives grade 4.0
 - 105-114 points receives grade 4.5
 - 115-125 points receives grade 5.0
5. Re-takes of the final examination will have the same form as the exam in the first attempt (see point 3 above).
