The AMBeR Partner Meeting and 3rd General Assembly took place in Klaipėda on October 22-23, 2024 bringing together over 40 participants from five partner countries at Klaipėda University. The discussions covered the implementation model for eCare, digital cancer rehabilitation, home monitoring of blood values for cancer patients, and a health economics study assessing blood tests in both clinical and home settings.
