

## INFORMATION CLAUSE REGARDING PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

### MultiCultiMed European Congress of Multiculturalism in Medicine and Health Sciences, May 25-27, 2026, Szczecin

In accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR), we inform you that:

#### 1. Data Controller

The controller of your personal data is the Pomeranian Medical University in Szczecin, ul. Rybacka 1, 70-204 Szczecin, Poland. The controller does not transfer participants' personal data to external entities, except for the cases indicated in point 5.

#### 2. Data Protection Officer (DPO)

The controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted via e-mail: [iod@pum.edu.pl](mailto:iod@pum.edu.pl) or in writing at the address of the data controller's headquarters.

#### 3. Purpose and Legal Basis for Personal Data Processing

Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:

- Recruitment, registration, and organization of participation in the Congress, including potential selection of participants based on form responses and organizational contact (info, program, organizational changes, materials, certificates) – legal basis: Art. 6(1)(b) and (f) GDPR.
- Logistical organization, including preparation of attendance lists, ID badges, accommodation services, and sending prizes to winners of online sessions – legal basis: Art. 6(1)(b) and (f) GDPR.
- Ensuring the inclusive nature of the event by providing organizational adjustments for persons reporting special needs – legal basis: Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR and Art. 9(2)(a) GDPR (consent for special categories of data).
- Documenting and promoting the Congress and the activities of PUM, including the publication of photos, video recordings, and online broadcasts – legal basis: Art. 6(1)(a) and (f) GDPR. To the extent that processing is based on Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR, you have the right to object pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR.

#### 4. Scope of Personal Data Processed

The registration form collects the following data:

- Identification and contact data (e.g., first and last name, email address, phone number, country and city of residence).
- Professional status, affiliation, and planned participation (e.g., represented organization, type of entity, position/role, preferred form of participation, information about potential presentations and participation in workshops).
- Data regarding special needs requiring organizational adjustment (optional, may indirectly indicate health status or disability, processed solely to ensure accessibility of the event based on separate consent).

#### 5. Recipients of Personal Data

Recipients of your personal data may include entities providing services to the controller (IT providers, technical support, photographers) and authorities authorized under applicable law.

**6. Data Retention Period**

Your personal data will be stored as follows:

- For registration and Congress organization: for the duration of the project and for 5 years after its completion, in accordance with the funder's requirements.
- For promotional materials (photos, recordings): indefinitely, until an objection is lodged or consent is withdrawn.
- For the period required by law or until the limitation period for potential claims expires.

**7. Rights of the Data Subject**

You have the following rights: access to data (Art. 15), rectification (Art. 16), erasure (Art. 17), restriction of processing (Art. 18), data portability (Art. 20), objection (Art. 21), withdrawal of consent, and the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

**8. Voluntary Provision of Data**

Providing data is voluntary but necessary for participation in the Congress. Failure to provide data will make participation impossible.

**9. Automated Decision-Making, Including Profiling**

Data will not be processed in an automated manner, including profiling.

**10. Source of Data**

Personal data is collected directly from the data subject via the registration form.
